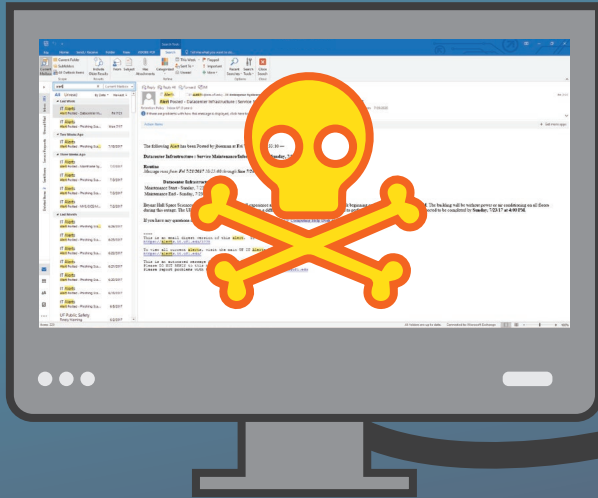


DON'T GET SCAMMED!



Phishing is a tactic in which cybercriminals try to steal your personal information through corrupt emails.

Use these helpful tips to avoid becoming a victim of cybercrime:

- ▶ Do not click on anything that makes you suspicious.
- ▶ Before clicking, hover your mouse pointer over a link in an email to see if the web address it goes to matches the company or organization.
- ▶ Look out for basic grammatical errors, misspelling of common words, or poor sentence structure.
- ▶ Forward suspicious emails from your UF email to abuse@ufl.edu.
